

Mandatory Immigration Check-in & iPREP Orientation Times, Procedures & Locations for Undergraduate Internationals

Failure to both check in and attend the iPREP Orientation session will result in a hold being placed on your academic record and you will not be able to register for classes.

Part 1: Check-in. During Check-in you will provide OISS with your original immigration documents, as well as the copies, and attend a visa compliance session.

Check-in Procedures:

Step 1: You must bring the following original immigration documents to check-in.

- passport with your visa stamp
- I-94 information (can be printed from <http://www.cbp.gov/i94>; please try to print this at the Marriott Hotel in advance!)
- I-20, DS-2019, or any applicable Approval Notice or other immigration documents

Step 2: Complete arrival paperwork

Step 3: Attend a mandatory visa compliance session with an OISS advisor

Step 4: Submit completed arrival paperwork for compliance verification

Part 2: iPREP Orientation. All undergraduate international students must attend the iPREP orientation session.
