- Food: On-campus restaurants and nearby restaurants are available to those who do not wish to purchase a meal card as part of their on-campus room & board package.
- Included Transportation: Shuttle to Target and Fiesta every Saturday morning, departing from the Graduate Apartments for food and supplies.
