Statement of Understanding: Deferred Coursework for Summer CPT

F-1 CPT authorization requires students to enroll in a course where off-campus employment is part of the established curriculum and a required component to receive a grade. [8 CFR § 214.2(f)(10)(i)]. If the relevant course is not offered during the summer, students may delay fulfilling this requirement until the fall semester.

Student's Agreement

By signing below I certify that I understand the following:

1. In order to participate in summer CPT without concurrent enrollment in an appropriate course, I must register for and successfully complete the designated CPT course in the following fall semester. Failure to do so would mean that I worked without authorization, thereby violating my F-1 status and causing OISS to terminate my F-1 SEVIS record for "unauthorized employment." I would then be required to depart the U.S. and apply for a new F-1 visa.
2. It is my responsibility to confirm with the professor of my CPT course that my summer employment will be an integral part of my fall coursework and meets all of the CPT requirements as per OISS' CPT handout.
